

Stahlrosenhof Puppy Information Package Breeding Program

My breeding program is extremely selective. Breedings are carefully planned years in advance because I have a vision and goal I wish to strive for. I have chosen not to breed, or not to continue breeding dogs who initially showed wonderful potential or had great working qualities and titles, but either lacked other characteristics I felt were vital to the breed, produced poorly, or did not fit into our current breeding program.

My founding stud dog, Ch. Brandy von Christel was out of import parents with both working titles, and AKC conformation championships. He was a hard dog, but very willing to please and exceptionally devoted. Throughout the years my focus has been maintaining those hard, working qualities with the beautiful structure Malinois are supposed to have. In looking to the future, I have not only the solid foundation lines I began with, I also have carefully chosen additions that will continue to compliment and produce the dogs that are a true credit to the breed.



The Stahlrosenhof puppies are not for everyone. They are serious dogs requiring proper raising and training. They require time and patience, as any working dog will. They are generally extreme in drives, dominant, demanding and exceptionally devoted. They need to work or have some type of job, or both puppy and owner will be miserable. While many working dog purists consider structure irrelevant, I have seen too many working dogs break down at an age where retirement should have been a long way off. My breeding program will continue to maintain the hard working qualities of the Malinois, and the solid structure to back them up.
